**Following the past three editions** that were held at Porte de Versailles in Paris, the Ouest France group - Le Marin - and the Construction Industries and Naval Activities Group (GICAN) chose to organise the next EUROMARITIME exhibition in the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur region.

**Located at the crossroads of international economic flows** between Europe and the Mediterranean region, Marseille benefits from being in the perfect strategic geographical location. It relies on the historical and commercial nature of its port - the oldest port in France - where the headquarters of CMA-CGM, a world leading container shipper and number one in France, are located. The Port of Marseille Fos has several assets: it will soon be a SmartPort, it is located near an offshore wind farm and it will be relaunching its ship repair service with the reopening of Forme 10, the 3rd largest ship repair facility in the world.
